- ◆ Accent or Stature
- ◆ Variety of Colour

# Ornamental Grasses

## Requirements

- ◆ Full Sun
- ◆ Moist Well Drained Soil
- ◆ Little to No Pruning
- ◆ Disease and Insect Resistant

# Ornamental Grasses

- ◆ Cool Season Grasses
- ◆ Warm Season Grasses

# Cool Season Grasses

- ◆ Grow Early Spring
- ◆ Flower by Mid Summer
- ◆ Transplant Spring or Fall

# Warm Season Grasses

- ◆ Requires 2 Weeks Warm Temps
- ◆ Grow Later in Spring
- ◆ Flowers Mid to Late Summer
- ◆ Transplant Only after Signs of Growth



# Blue Oat Grass

- ◆ Cool Season
- ◆ Clump Forming
- ◆ Steel Blue  
Foliage



## Blue Oat Grass

- ◆ Full Sun to Part Shade
- ◆ Good Drainage
- ◆ Drought Tolerant
- ◆ Propagate through Early Spring Division
- ◆ Use with Russian Sage, Blanket Flower, Sedum, other tall Ornamental Grasses



# Flame Grass



# Flame Grass

- ◆ Warm Season
- ◆ Clump Forming
- ◆ Green to Coppery Bronze in Autumn
- ◆ Four to Five Feet Tall

# Flame Grass

- ◆ Full Sun
- ◆ Well Drained Soil
- ◆ Pest Free
- ◆ Little Maintenance
- ◆ Propagate through Division

# Karl Foerster

- ◆ Cool Season
- ◆ Clump Forming
- ◆ Green with Tall Plumes that Sway in the Breeze



# Karl Foerster

- ◆ Full Sun to Part Shade
- ◆ Well Drained, Fertile Soil
- ◆ Not Drought Tolerant
- ◆ Propagate Through Division
- ◆ Combine with Late Summer / Fall Blooming Perennials
